DAY 1 - SATURDAY

MILAN

At 6:00 PM, meet the tour leader at the reception.

DAY 2 - SUNDAY

MILAN - PORTOFINO -SANTA MARGHERITA LIGURE - RAPALLO - LA SPEZIA

After breakfast, the day is dedicated to exploring the Gulf of Tigullio. Discover Portofino, with its elegant harmony and brightly colored buildings overlooking the sea, and Santa Margherita Ligure, known for its pastel-colored facades and stunning promenade. In the afternoon, take a boat to Rapallo, a historic town in the heart of the Gulf of Tigullio. Later, transfer to the hotel in La Spezia for free time.

DAY 3 - MONDAY

LA SPEZIA

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Cinque Terre

Weather permitting, take a boat or train to the Cinque Terre. Over centuries, humans have shaped this unique landscape with terraces along the slopes, creating one of Liguria's most beautiful and iconic panoramas. Explore Manarola, a true urban gem with its charming harbor and pastel-colored houses; Vernazza, one of Italy's most beautiful villages, with its amphitheater-like harbor extending toward the sea; and Monterosso, the largest and westernmost of the Cinque Terre villages, featuring a picturesque natural bay. Return to the hotel in the afternoon.





DAY 4 - TUESDAY

LA SPEZIA - FLORENCE

Breakfast and departure to Florence, a city with an atmosphere that invites you to travel back in time, known worldwide as the birthplace of the Renaissance and the cradle of architecture and art. Guided tour of its historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, surrounded by churches, monuments, and beautiful Renaissance buildings praised by poets throughout the ages. The Baptistery of Saint John, dedicated to the city's patron saint, the famous Giotto's Campanile, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, and the imposing dome by Brunelleschi are just a few examples of the wonders Florence offers. After the tour, transfer to the hotel.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

The Uffizi Gallery

Designed in the mid-16th century by Giorgio Vasari, the Uffizi Gallery comprises 90 rooms housing some of the most important and famous paintings in art history: works by Giotto, Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and numerous paintings by Flemish and Dutch artists, displayed in chronological order. A visit to this museum is a true journey through art history.

DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY

FLORENCE

Breakfast and free time.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Florence - Oltrarno

Located on the left bank of the Arno River, Oltrarno is one of the city's most typical areas, offering a unique, timeless atmosphere mainly populated by locals. Highlights include a visit to the Ponte Vecchio, with its shops and hanging houses, one of the world's most famous landmarks, and the Pitti Palace, the last residence of the Medici family and now Florence's largest museum complex.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION: Accademia Gallery

The Accademia Gallery is one of the city's and the world's most important museums. Among its masterpieces is Michelangelo's unparalleled David, one of the most famous sculptures globally and a universal symbol of Florence.

DAY 6 - THURSDAY

FLORENCE - ROME

Breakfast and departure by train to Rome. Transfer to the hotel and free time

DAY 7 - FRIDAY

Breakfast at the hotel and a panoramic tour of Rome to admire the magnificent monuments symbolizing Ancient Rome: the Colosseum, Circus Maximus, Palatine Hill, Caracalla Baths, and the most representative basilicas of Christian Rome: St. Paul Outside the Walls, St. John Lateran, Santa Maria Maggiore, and St. Peter's Basilica. The tour continues along the Tiber River, offering views of Castel Sant'Angelo and the Ara Pacis. It concludes with a bus ride through the magnificent Villa Borghese and the elegant Via Veneto, the avenue of Hollywood stars, bars, and Rome's most elegant hotels. During the tour, there will be a stop at the Capitoline Hill for a panoramic view of the Roman Forum and the magnificent Piazza Venezia. We will also stop at St. Peter's Square, where it will be possible to continue with an optional visit to the Vatican Museums. Free time and return to the hotel.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION: Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel

The Vatican Museums, considered among the most important in the world, and the Sistine Chapel, the site of the Papal Conclave, magnificently painted by Michelangelo Buonarroti. This visit immerses you in the highest expressions of art throughout history, where beauty and faith combine in a unique harmony—an unmissable experience in Rome.

DAY 8 - SATURDAY

ROME

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Ancient Rome

Guided tour with included entrance to the most evocative and imposing monument of antiquity, the Colosseum, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. The tour continues to the archaeological area of the Roman Forum, a symbol of the Italian capital, showcasing the architectural mastery of the Roman Empire.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Tivoli and its Magnificent Villas: Villa Adriana and Villa D'Este In the afternoon, enjoy a half-day visit to the town of Tivoli. Stro-Il through the ruins of Villa Adriana from the Roman era, with its temples, theaters, and statues. Then explore the romantic Villa d'Este, a Renaissance masterpiece featuring waterfalls, pools, and fountains in its gardens. At the end of the tour, return to Rome.

DAY 9 - SUNDAY

ROME - POMPEII - NAPLES

Breakfast and departure for the Campania region. Arrival in Pompeii for a guided tour of the archaeological ruins buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD, along with Herculaneum, Stabia, and Oplonti. After the visit, enjoy lunch with the opportunity to savor the famous Neapolitan pizza. In the afternoon, trans-







fer to the hotel in Naples.

DAY 10 - MONDAY

NAPLES - AMALFI - POSITANO - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and a day trip by boat to Positano and Amalfi. Begin with a visit to Amalfi, the splendid city that lends its name to the entire coast and is renowned for its maritime history, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Use your free time to visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew and the Paper Museum. Continue to Positano, the jewel of the Amalfi Coast, with its unique atmosphere, picturesque alleys, small shops, and vibrant ceramics. Capture the magic of this enchanting location with postcard-worthy photos from the sea. Return to Naples in the evening.

DAY 11 - TUESDAY

NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Capri


