# ROME

At 6:00 PM, meet the tour leader at the reception.

#### DAY 2 - SATURDAY

## ROME

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

## **OPTIONAL EXCURSION:**

#### **Ancient Rome**

Guided tour with included entrance to the most evocative and imposing monument of antiquity, the Colosseum, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. The tour continues to the archaeological area of the Roman Forum, a symbol of the Italian capital, showcasing the architectural mastery of the Roman Empire.

#### **OPTIONAL EXCURSION:**

**Tivoli and its Magnificent Villas: Villa Adriana and Villa D'Este** In the afternoon, enjoy a half-day visit to the town of Tivoli. Stroll through the ruins of Villa Adriana from the Roman era, with its temples, theaters, and statues. Then explore the romantic Villa d'Este, a Renaissance masterpiece featuring waterfalls, pools, and fountains in its gardens. At the end of the tour, return to Rome.

#### DAY 3 - SUNDAY

# ROME - POMPEII - NAPLES

Breakfast and departure for the Campania region. Arrival in Pompeii for a guided tour of the archaeological ruins buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD, along with Herculaneum, Stabia, and Oplonti. After the visit, enjoy lunch with the

opportunity to savor the famous Neapolitan pizza. In the afternoon, transfer to the hotel in Naples.

DAY 4 - MONDAY

# NAPLES - AMALFI - POSITANO - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and a day trip by boat to Positano and Amalfi. Begin with a visit to Amalfi, the splendid city that lends its name to the entire coast and is renowned for its maritime history, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Use your free time to visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew and the Paper Museum. Continue to Positano, the jewel of the Amalfi Coast, with its unique atmosphere, picturesque alleys, small shops, and vibrant ceramics. Capture the magic of this enchanting location with postcard-worthy photos from the sea. Return to Naples in the evening.

# NAPLES - CAPRI - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

#### OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

#### Capri

Discover the most famous island in the Campanian Archipelago. Located in the Gulf of Naples, Capri has charmed emperors, artists, and celebrities for centuries with its breathtaking landscapes, secret coves, lively streets, cliffs, and panoramic views. The visit includes lunch at a traditional restaurant. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

Optional: Boat tour and visit to the Blue Grotto

#### DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by transfer to the train station to depart for Milan. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel and check-in to the reserved rooms.

DAY 7 - THURSDAY

## MILAN

Milan is also famous as Italy's fashion capital, a hub of industry, and a nerve center of the Italian economy. A walk through Milan must include its iconic landmarks: Piazza del Duomo, one of Italy's largest and most breathtaking squares, with the imposing Gothic-style Cathedral; Teatro alla Scala, a cultural symbol of Milan and one of the world's most prestigious theaters for history, architecture, and performances; and the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. Free time and return to the hotel.

## Milan's Navigli District

Explore the Navigli district, one of Milan's most picturesque areas, renowned for its vibrant nightlife and numerous bars and restaurants along the canals. Enjoy an evening aperitivo during "happy hour" after a brief stroll to discover the history of this charming neighborhood.

DAY 8 - FRIDAY

# MILAN - LAKE MAGGIORE: STRESA AND BORROMEAN ISLANDS - MILAN

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Stresa, a splendid tourist destination on Lake Maggiore. This charming village is set in a unique landscape offering stunning views of the Alps and Lake Maggiore, home to the famous Borromean Islands. Next is an excursion to the Borromean Islands, including Isola Bella with its monumental palace, Isola dei Pescatori (Fishermen's Island) with its picturesque charm, and Isola Madre, known for its botanical gardens filled with rare plants. Lunch will be on Isola dei Pescatori, featuring local cuisine. Return to Stresa for some

free time, then back to the hotel in the afternoon.

### Lake Como - Como, Villa Carlotta, and Bellagio

Continue to Tremezzo to visit Villa Carlotta, overlooking the lake and surrounded by magnificent gardens. A boat ride will take you to Bellagio, one of the most enchanting towns on Lake Como, where you can enjoy free time to explore its charming corners. Return to the hotel in the afternoon
