# ROME

# DAY 2 - SATURDAY

# ROME

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

# OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

# **Ancient Rome**

Guided tour with included entrance to the most evocative and imposing monument of antiquity, the Colosseum, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. The tour continues to the archaeological area of the Roman Forum, a symbol of the Italian capital, showcasing the architectural mastery of the Roman Empire.

# OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

**Tivoli and its Magnificent Villas - Villa Adriana and Villa d'Este** In the afternoon, enjoy a half-day visit to the town of Tivoli. Stroll through the ruins of Villa Adriana from the Roman era, with its temples, theaters, and statues. Then explore the romantic Villa d'Este, a Renaissance masterpiece featuring waterfalls, pools, and fountains in its gardens. At the end of the tour, return to Rome.

#### DAY 3 - SUNDAY

# ROME - POMPEII - NAPLES

Breakfast and departure for the Campania region. Arrival in Pompeii for a guided tour of the archaeological ruins buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD, along with Herculaneum, Stabia, and Oplonti. After the visit, enjoy lunch with the opportunity to savor the famous Neapolitan pizza. In the afternoon, transfer to the hotel in Naples.

# DAY 4 - MONDAY

# NAPLES - AMALFI - POSITANO - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and a day trip by boat to Positano and Amalfi. Begin with a visit to Amalfi, the splendid city that lends its name to the entire coast and is renowned for its maritime history, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Use your free time to visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew and the Paper Museum. Continue to Positano, the jewel of the Amalfi Coast, with its unique atmosphere, picturesque alleys, small shops, and vibrant ceramics. Capture the magic of this enchanting location with postcard-worthy photos from the sea. Return to Naples in the evening.

# DAY 5 - TUESDAY

# NAPLES - CAPRI - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

# **OPTIONAL EXCURSION:**

# Capri

Discover the most famous island in the Campanian Archipelago. Located in the Gulf of Naples, Capri has charmed emperors, artists, and celebrities for centuries with its breathtaking landscapes, secret coves, lively streets, cliffs, and panoramic views. The visit includes lunch at a traditional restaurant. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

Optional: Boat tour and visit to the Blue Grotto

# DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY

# NAPLES - ANDRIA - BARI

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Puglia. Stop en route to visit Castel del Monte in Andria, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a mysterious 13th-century castle built by Emperor Frederick II. Transfer to the hotel in Bari for check-in.

# Old Bari

Explore the charming Old Town of Bari, where time seems to stand still amidst its simplicity and authenticity. The narrow streets reflect a history rich in traditions passed down through generations.

### DAY 7 - THURSDAY

# BARI - POLIGNANO A MARE -MONOPOLI - BARI

After breakfast, visit Polignano a Mare, a stunning medieval village perched on a rugged cliff. Stroll through its whitewashed streets and terraces offering unique views of the sea. Continue to Monopoli, known as the "City of a Hundred Districts." Explore its historic center, the Baroque cathedral, and the seafront. Return to the hotel.

# **Polignano Caves by Boat**

Enjoy a two-hour boat tour from San Vito harbor in Polignano a Mare, visiting the main caves and stunning coastal vistas. The excursion includes a stop for swimming.

#### DAY 8 - FRIDAY

# BARI - ALBEROBELLO -LOCOROTONDO - LECCE

Breakfast and departure to Alberobello, famous for its trulli, traditional white stone huts dating back to the 16th century and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue to Locorotondo, a charming village with whitewashed streets, colorful flowers, and panoramic views over the valley. Transfer to the hotel in Lecce.

Breakfast at the hotel and free time.

#### DAY 10 - SUNDAY

# LECCE - OSTUNI - BARI

After breakfast, depart for Ostuni, the "White City," known for its charming historic center with narrow streets, whitewashed houses, and artisan shops. After the visit, transfer to your hotel in Bari.

# **Bari Food Tour**

Experience Bari like a local with a food tour led by a culinary expert. Taste traditional dishes in authentic venues known only to locals.

# BARI - MATERA - NAPLES

Breakfast and departure to Matera, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's oldest cities. Tour the iconic Sassi di Matera, ancient cave dwellings, and churches carved into the rock. Continue to Naples and check in at the hotel.
