DAY 1 - WEDNESDAY

MILAN

Arrival at Milan airport and transfer to the hotel. Free time. At 6:00 PM, meet with the tour leader at the hotel reception.

DAY 2 - THURSDAY

MILAN

Breakfast at the hotel and visit to Milan, which boasts an invaluable historical, artistic, and architectural heritage. Milan is also famous for other aspects: it is the Italian fashion capital, an industrial hub, and a key center for the Italian economy. A tour of Milan wouldn't be complete without visiting some of the city's iconic spots: Piazza del Duomo, one of Italy's largest and most enchanting squares, with the imposing Gothic-style Duomo and La Scala Theatre, a cultural symbol of Milan and one of the most prestigious theaters in the world for its history, architecture, and performances, not to mention the Vittorio Emanuele II Gallery. Free time and return to the hotel.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Navigli District of Milan: A Symbol of Milan's Nightlife

An excursion to explore the Navigli district, one of the most picturesque areas of Milan, renowned worldwide for its vibrant nightlife and the hundreds of venues along its canal banks. During the visit, take a break to admire the illuminated, one of the most striking Gothic cathedrals, the impressive Duomo of Milan. After a short walk to discover the history of this charming neighborhood, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy an aperitif during the "happy hour."

DAY 3 - FRIDAY

MILAN - LAKE MAGGIORE: STRESA
AND BORROMEAN ISLANDS - MILAN



Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Stresa, a splendid tourist destination on Lake Maggiore. This charming town is nestled in an unparalleled scenic setting, offering breathtaking views of the Alps and Lake Maggiore, home to the famous Borromean Islands. Next, enjoy an excursion to the Borromean Islands, featuring the monumental Isola Bella, the picturesque Isola dei Pescatori, and Isola Madre, renowned for its botanical garden filled with rare plants. During the excursion, lunch will be served on Isola dei Pescatori, featuring typical dishes of the local cuisine. Return to Stresa and enjoy free time before heading back to the hotel in the afternoon.

DAY 4 - SATURDAY

MILAN - LAKE COMO: COMO, VILLA CARLOTTA, AND BELLAGIO - MILAN

After breakfast, departure to Como for a guided tour of one of the most beloved cities in northern Italy. Highlights include the Duomo, the Broletto (medieval town hall), the Terragni Palace, ancient alleys, and remnants of the medieval city walls. Transfer to Tremezzo for a guided visit to Villa Carlotta, which overlooks the lake and is surrounded by a magnificent park filled with stunning plants and flowers. From Tremezzo, take a boat transfer to Bellagio, one of the most beautiful tourist destinations on Lake Como. Enjoy free time to soak in the charming atmosphere and explore the enchanting corners of this gem, often called the "Pearl of Lake Como." In the afternoon, return to the hotel. In the evening, enjoy a dinner featuring typical local dishes from the region.

DAY 5 - SUNDAY

MILAN - PORTOFINO - SANTA MARGHERITA LIGURE - RAPALLO - LA SPEZIA

After breakfast at the hotel, we will dedicate the day to exploring the Gulf of Tigullio. Visit Portofino, renowned for its elegant charm and vibrant-colored buildings overlooking the sea, and Santa Margherita Ligure, famous for its pastel-colored facades and its stunning promenade. In the afternoon, take a boat ride back to Rapallo, a city rich in historical heritage, situated at the heart of the Gulf of Tigullio. Later in the day, transfer to the hotel in La Spezia and enjoy free time.

DAY 6 - MONDAY

LA SPEZIA - CINQUE TERRE - LA SPEZIA

Breakfast at the hotel, and we will continue our journey to the Cinque Terre, traveling by boat or train depending on weather conditions. Over centuries, human ingenuity has shaped this territory by building the famous terraces that make use of the geography of its slopes, creating one of the most beautiful and iconic landscapes of Liguria. The guided tour begins with Manarola, an urban gem with its charming harbor and a cluster of pastel-colored houses. Next is Vernazza, considered one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, preserving its long maritime traditions. Its natural harbor, shaped like an amphitheater extending into the sea, attests to this legacy. Finally, we visit Monterosso, the westernmost and most populous town of the Cinque Terre. Located in a small natural gulf, it consists of two settlements: the historic center to the east and the more modern, tourist-oriented area to the west. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

DÍA 7 - TUESDAY

LA SPEZIA - FLORENCE

Breakfast and departure to Florence, a city with an atmosphere that invites you to travel back in time. Renowned worldwide as the birthplace of the Renaissance, Florence is the cradle of architecture and art. Enjoy a guided tour of its historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, surrounded by churches, monuments, and stunning Renaissance buildings praised by poets throughout history. Highlights include the Baptistery of St. John,



dedicated to the city's patron saint, the famous Giotto's Campanile, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, and Brunelleschi's imposing dome—just a few examples of Florence's wonders. After the visit, transfer to the hotel.

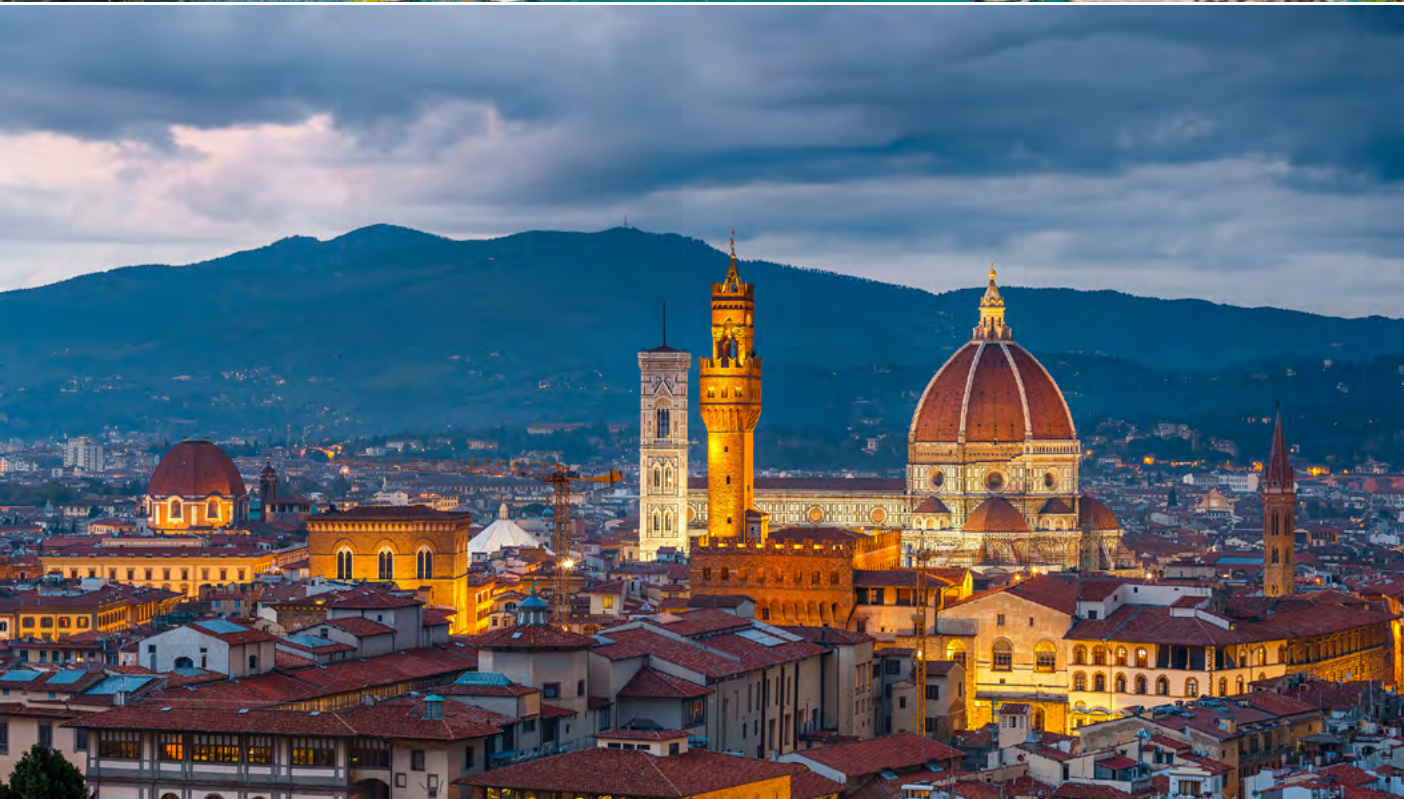
OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

The Uffizi Gallery

The Uffizi Gallery, designed in the mid-16th century by Giorgio Vasari, consists of 90 rooms housing some of the most important and famous paintings in the history of art. It features masterpieces by Giotto, Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, and Botticelli, as well as numerous works by Flemish and Dutch painters, all displayed in chronological order. A visit to this museum is truly a journey through time, exploring the evolution of art and its timeless beauty.

DAY 8 - WEDNESDAY

FLORENCE



After breakfast, we will begin our second day in Florence by exploring one of the most authentic areas of the city: Oltrarno, located on the left bank of the Arno River. This district exudes a unique and timeless atmosphere, offering a glimpse into a more genuine Florence, populated mostly by locals. A visit to the Ponte Vecchio is a must. With its hanging shops and houses, it stands as one of the most famous landmarks in the world. We will also visit the Palazzo Pitti, the last residence of the Medici family and now the largest museum complex in Florence. Enjoy free time before returning to the hotel.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

The Accademia Gallery

The Accademia Gallery is one of the most important museums in Florence and the world. Among its most significant works is Michelangelo's unparalleled David, one of the most famous sculptures globally and a universal symbol of the city of Florence.



DAY 9 - THURSDAY

FLORENCE - ROMA

Breakfast and departure by train to Rome. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel and enjoy free time to explore the city at your own pace. In the evening, savor a delightful dinner featuring typical Roman dishes in the charming Trastevere district, known for its lively atmosphere and authentic local cuisine.

DAY 10 - FRIDAY

ROME

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by a panoramic tour of Rome to admire the magnificent monuments of Ancient Rome: the Colosseum, Circus Maximus, Palatine Hill, Baths of Caracalla, and the most iconic Christian basilicas of the city: St. Paul Outside the Walls, St. John Lateran, Santa Maria Maggiore, and St. Peter's Basilica. The tour continues along the Tiber River, offering views of Castel Sant'Angelo and the Ara Pacis. The bus will then pass through the splendid Villa Borghese gardens and the elegant Via Veneto, famous for its connection to Hollywood stars, luxurious bars, and elegant hotels. During the tour, there will be a stop at the Capitoline Hill for a panoramic view of the Roman Forum and the magnificent Piazza Venezia. Another stop will be made at St. Peter's Square, where you will have the option to continue with a visit to the Vatican Museums. Enjoy free time in the afternoon before returning to the hotel.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel

The Vatican Museums, considered one of the most important in the world, and the Sistine Chapel, the site of the Papal Conclave, masterfully painted by Michelangelo Buonarroti. This visit immerses you in the highest expressions of art across all eras, where beauty and faith converge in a unique and unparalleled combination. A must-see experience in Rome.

DAY 11 - SATURDAY

ROME

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by a guided tour with included admission to the most iconic and imposing monument of antiquity, the Colosseum, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Next, visit the archaeological area of the Roman Forum, a symbol of the Italian capital that showcases the architectural mastery of the Roman Empire. Enjoy free time in the afternoon before transferring to Civitavecchia to board the overnight ferry to Olbia.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Tivoli and its Magnificent Villas: Villa Adriana and Villa D'Este

In the afternoon, there is an option to take a half-day tour to the city of Tivoli. You will have the chance to stroll through the ruins of Villa Adriana, dating back to Roman times, with its temples, theaters, and statues. Then, we will visit the romantic Villa D'Este, a Renaissance masterpiece famous for its waterfalls, pools, and fountains set within beautiful gardens. This unforgettable experience offers a glimpse into the history and beauty of two of Italy's most stunning sites. At the end of the tour, we will return to Rome.

DAY 12 - SUNDAY

ROME - POMPEII - NAPLES

After breakfast, depart for the Campania region. Transfer to Pompeii and enjoy a guided tour of the archaeological ruins buried under lava during the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD, alongside other ancient cities like Herculaneum, Stabiae, and Oplontis. After the visit, enjoy lunch where you'll have the chance to taste the famous Neapolitan pizza. In the afternoon, transfer to the hotel.

DAY 13 - MONDAY

NAPLES - AMALFI - POSITANO - NAPLES

Breakfast at the hotel and then a boat excursion from Naples to Amalfi and Positano. Upon arrival in Amalfi, visit the splendid city that gives its name to the entire coast, famous for being one of

the ancient maritime republics, and declared a UNESCO World Heritage site. Don't miss the chance to visit the famous Cathedral of Saint Andrew and the Paper Museum during your free time. Afterward, continue to Positano, the pearl of the Amalfi Coast, with its unique atmosphere, narrow streets, small shops, and colorful ceramics. Capture the magic of the place with a postcard-like photo from the sea before concluding your day of exploration. In the late afternoon, return to the hotel in Naples.

DAY 14 - TUESDAY

NAPLES - CAPRI - NAPLES

After breakfast, transfer to the port to board the boat to Capri, the most famous island of the Campanian archipelago. Located across from the Sorrentine Peninsula in the Gulf of Naples, Capri has been captivating emperors, artists, and celebrities for centuries. It's the most iconic island, frequently appearing in films and advertising campaigns. With nearly year-round sunshine, visiting Capri offers access to breathtaking spots: secret coves, lively alleys, cliffs, and mountains with spectacular panoramas. During the visit, enjoy a lunch break at one of the island's typical restaurants. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

DAY 15 - WEDNESDAY

NAPLES

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport/station. End of services.
