DAY 1 - SATURDAY

CATANIA

Arrival at Catania Airport and transfer to the hotel. Free time. At 6:00 PM, meet the tour leader in the reception area.

DAY 2 - SUNDAY

CATANIA - TAORMINA - CATANIA

After breakfast at the hotel, depart for Taormina, the splendid Sicilian city renowned for its Greek-Roman theater, medieval streets, breathtaking views, beautiful beaches, and excellent gastronomy. Walk through the city's main streets, filled with shops, and reach the magnificent Cathedral Square, where you can enjoy a delightful ice cream while admiring the spectacular bay. Free time and return to the hotel. Accommodation.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION:

Mount Etna, Europe's Highest Volcano

Mount Etna, the most active volcano on Earth, is fondly called "A Muntagna" by the locals of Catania. This attraction offers fascinating sights, such as lava fields from ancient and recent eruptions, villages destroyed by past activity, extinct craters, and the impressive Valle del Bove caldera. Visitors can marvel at the active summit craters and enjoy a tasting of local wines and products during the excursion.

DAY 3 - MONDAY

CATANIA - SYRACUSE -NOTO - RAGUSA After breakfast, head to Syracuse, one of the most beautiful cities in Sicily, characterized by its white stone streets and ancient buildings. Visit the Archaeological Park of Neapolis, showcasing monuments from different historical eras, and the island of Ortigia, the heart of Syracuse, rich in freshwater springs and centuries of history. Continue to Noto, famously called the "Baroque Capital," loved for its stunning art, culture, and grandiose palaces. Transfer to the hotel in Ragusa. Accommodation.

DAY 4 - TUESDAY


RAGUSA - MODICA - RAGUSA

After breakfast, explore Ragusa Ibla, the historic center celebrated worldwide for its over fifty churches and numerous palaces, representing the pinnacle of Sicilian Baroque. Perched on a hill, Ibla offers stunning views of the surrounding valley. Visit the nearby town of Modica, rich in history, natural beauty, and gastronomy. During the tour, enjoy a tasting of Modica's famous chocolate. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY

RAGUSA - PIAZZA ARMERINA - AGRIGENTO - PALERMO

After breakfast, depart for Piazza Armerina to visit the Villa Romana del Casale, renowned for its magnificent mosaics depicting the daily life and mythology of ancient Rome. Continue to Agrigento for a visit to the Valley of the Temples, one of the best-preserved Greek archaeological sites. The area spans 1,300 hectares, making it the world's largest archaeological park. After the tour, transfer to Palermo for dinner featuring local dishes. Accommodation.





DAY 6 - THURSDAY

PALERMO

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and a free morning. Optional: Join a Food Tour to discover Palermo's culinary delights. In the afternoon, visit Palermo's historical landmarks, including churches, palaces, squares, and bustling markets. Free time and return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 7 - FRIDAY

PALERMO - ERICE - TRAPANI - PALERMO

After breakfast, visit Erice, a charming medieval town perched on a hill, offering breathtaking views and romantic sunsets. Highlights include the Cathedral of Erice and the Venus Castle. Sample the traditional pastry "Genovese." Continue to Trapani, exploring its historic center, Senatorio Palace, and Porta Oscura, which divides the original town from the expanded area. Visit Torre Ligny, now a museum of prehistory. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 8 - SATURDAY

PALERMO - MONREALE -CEFALÙ - CATANIA

After breakfast, travel to Monreale to visit its Norman Cathedral, celebrated for its stunning Byzantine mosaics. Continue to Cefalù, one of Italy's most beautiful villages, known for its medieval alleys and charming seaside houses. Enjoy lunch featuring local dishes. End the day in Catania. Accommodation


